- This course was excellent; Dr. Safii did an amazing job teaching the material in a way that made it accessible for everyone.
- Professor Soheil, I just want to say you are a very strong professor in the sense that it is very easy to follow and understand. I think you made your lectures very clear and if someone didn't get something they should just go to your office hours hours because you really help clarify some problems. I do want to say however that sometimes you "break down" the math too much and we start doing math from the very bottom (simple math). I think it slows the class down but then again, I am not sure where the learning curve is for every student.
- I do not write comments very often, but Prof. Safii is best professor I have had in math so far! Very patient, clear, and concise in teaching the material to students. Expectations for the course, quizzes, midterm, and final were explained very well. I appreciate how he does not skip steps while doing math examples because it made the material so much easier to understand and to study for. The professor always, always asks his students for any questions during lesson which shows his concern for his students' understanding rather than just getting the class over with and homework turned in.
